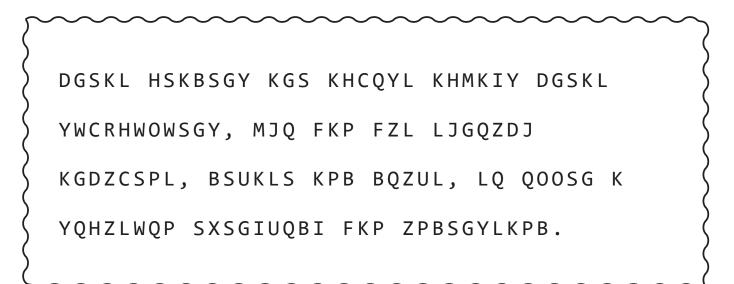
Colin Powell (b. 1937)
